These instructions are logical integrated concepts that allow an individual to repair ill health, poor relationships or monetary hardships. They allow those who have been unable to have children to conceive; those that have been unable to find love, to be loved; those that have been unable to provide, to achieve abundance.

In order to utilize these instructions, you must learn them. And you cannot learn them from syncretized philosophies that have welded the inconsistencies, fear dependency and secrecy of Western religions into their fabric.
